Jim Forrest and the Ad Lib team helped get this "Slow" reminder in Mays Lane near the Pembury Road junction.

But many drivers still exceed the speed limit on the blind bend here.

This endangers drivers trying to pull out of Pembury Road. And it's a nightmare for pedestrians - many of them elderly - trying to cross to and from the bus stops.

We'll take this up again to try



to persuade the Council to offer more protection.

We're also taking up residents' complaints about speeding in Gosport Road.
